The Peninsula Fire District is located on the shores of Lake Almanor in Plumas County. The District covers 6 square miles including a business district, rural residential areas, a gated community with a golf course, and an up and coming residential golf development. The District also responds to emergencies on a local State Highway. The District averages 150-170 responses a year, 80% being medical emergencies.

PERSONNEL: 1 Fulltime Fire Chief, 3 Captains, 15 Firefighters and 3 Volunteer Firefighters.

EQUIPMENT: 2 ALS Ambulances, 1 Rescue / Mini Pumper, 3 Engines and a Hover Craft for ice rescues all operated out of 2 Fire Stations.

PAY: Per-Day Employees – 24 hour shifts:
Firefighter/EMT = \$215.00 - \$255.00
Firefighter/MICP = \$245.00 - \$285.00

BENEFITS: Uniform and Tuition allowance. Holiday pay.

REQUIREMENTS: Valid CA Drivers Class B Firefighter license. High school graduate or equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade. Preferred; CA FF-I or graduate from an approved FF-I academy. Valid CA Paramedic License or EMT-1.

JOB DESCRIPTION: The Peninsula Fire District responds to a wide range of emergencies. Employees have a variety of skills and qualifications including: Haz-Mat Technician, certified divers, ALS skills and other State Fire Marshall Certificates. Our training and ability to pursue other educational opportunities help us maintain a professional level of emergency services.

As well as serving the public, the District employees perform a majority of the vehicle maintenance, station maintenance and other duties as assigned.
